SEATING DETAILS | Seating assignments for subscriptions will be determined by staff in order of receipt. Please contact the Box Office if you have questions regarding accessibility or special requests for assistance.

PROCESSING OF ORDERS | All fees and taxes are included in the price of the ticket. Ticket orders are filled in the order they are received, with subscriptions receiving priority over single-ticket orders. **For preferred seating, send in your subscriptions by September 14.**

SENIOR, STUDENT, AND YOUNG ADULT DISCOUNTS | Discounted tickets for Seniors (age 65+) and Young Adults (under age 40) are available in price sections A and B. Young Adult tickets will be held at the door; please present a valid driver's license. Reserved seating for Full-Time Students under age 30 is available for \$10 in Section B & C.

STUDENT RUSH TICKETS | FREE Student Rush tickets (in-person and virtual) for youth under 18 and full-time students with student ID. Limited numbers. Please email info@apollosfire.org or call 216.320.0012 x 1 for details.

PRESTO SEATS | \$12 Presto Seats go on sale 3 weeks prior to each concert; seating is guaranteed but is assigned by the box office. ORDER EARLY! Tickets

may only be purchased by phone: 216.320.0012 x 1. Limit of 2 Presto Seats per order. All sales are final, and Presto Seats may not be exchanged.

GROUP DISCOUNTS | Group discounts are available in price sections B and C and may be purchased by contacting the Box Office. Groups of 10-14 will receive a 10% discount, groups of 15-19 will receive a 15% discount, and groups of 20 or more will receive a 20% discount off of the regular ticket price.

EXCHANGES | Tickets (other than Presto Seats) may be exchanged for other performances in the 2022-2023 subscription series. The box office will charge a \$2 per ticket exchange fee as well as the balance for ticket(s) to a more expensive performance, if applicable. Subscribers receive free exchange privileges. All exchanges must be received in the box office no later than 48 hours before the event.

TICKET DONATIONS | If you cannot use your tickets, you may receive acknowledgment for a tax-deductible donation for the value of the tickets. Donated tickets must be returned to the box office at least 48 hours prior to the performance. Ticket purchases are non-refundable except in the case of COVID cancellations.

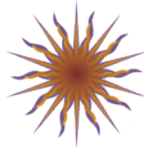
