Fun Facts: Bologne was called Chevalier (knight) of St. George

-He was french-African, his mother was a slave and his father a wealthy plantation & slave owner

- He was amazing at Fencing, one of the best in France
- -Played for The Queen of France and the French Royal Orchestra

- One of the few women composers from the Baroque Era
- Her father was a famous poet, her mother was a servant
- By the time she was 15 years old she was signing in concerts, sometimes singing her own music!
- She wrote 8 volumes of music throughout her life
- Was a mother of 4 children
